Neuroradiologist

Allegheny Radiology Associates is seeking to add a seventh member to the Division of Neuroradiology. Qualifications include certification by the American Board of Radiology in Diagnostic Radiology and completion of fellowship training in the subspecialty; a Certificate of Added Qualifications in Neuroradiology or eligibility for such is desirable.

The successful candidate will participate fully in a busy division, taking part in a wide range of diagnostic neuroradiology services, including CT (including CT angiography and perfusion), head and neck PET/CT imaging, MR imaging (including MR angiography, diffusion-weighted imaging, and spectroscopy), diagnostic angiography, and myelography. Procedures performed include spinal biopsies, epidural steroid injections, facet and nerve blocks, discography, and vertebroplasty. A nurse practitioner, a physician's assistant, and one neuroradiology fellow assist with procedures.

A wide range of vascular interventional neuroradiology services include endovascular treatment of intracranial aneurysms, arteriovenous malformations, tumors, and arteriovenous fistulae. Neurointerventionalists also perform intracranial, intraarterial thrombolysis for acute stroke and provide treatment of arterial vasospasm resulting from subarachnoid hemorrhage. Angioplasty and stenting of spastic or atherosclerotic vessels is also performed.

Equipment includes nine 1.5 Tesla magnets; nine CT scanners, including a 128-slice dual source, a 64-slice, a 40-slice; a 16-slice PET CT; two biplane and two single plane angiography suites.

The faculty support a complement of 28 residents, as well as an accredited fellowship. The successful candidate will also actively participate in the training program in terms of clinical and didactic teaching.

As a campus of Drexel University College of Medicine, academic appointment to the Faculty of DUCOM is available.

The physician will be employed by Allegheny Radiology Associates, Ltd., a private practice group consisting of 26 radiologists. Total compensation package for the first year will be \$400K to \$450K, commensurate with experience. Benefits include: pension/profit-sharing plan (fully vested after one year of service); malpractice coverage; health coverage for physician and family, etc. An offer of partnership can be anticipated at no more than two years of employment, depending on experience.

Allegheny General Hospital is an 829-bed academic health center offering a wide array of medical and surgical services. AGH was the first hospital in the region to receive designation as a Level I Shock Trauma Center, and our LifeFlight aeromedical service was the first to fly in the northeastern United States.
